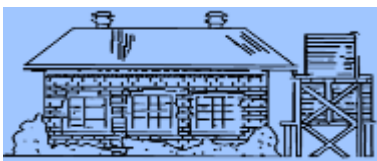

Other Wellington schools that have larger enrolments will continue remote learning for the first week of Term 4 and begin on Oct 12th. Any Bundy family wishing to continue remote learning for the extra week is welcome to do so but must let us know if they want work prepared for them.
